A W.S.C.C. marshaling initiative for 2008

So anyone that would like to marshal, predominantly, but not solely, at a Toyo Tyres / WSCC Speed Series round, whether experienced or new to marshaling – If you are a member of the W.S.C.C. **register NOW**

The idea is to increase the number of marshals at events and promote marshaling within the club.

As a further incentive to increase marshaling numbers there will be awards based on a points system.

Full details of the awards are to be confirmed in due course, but it will definitely include a trophy to be presented at the Toyo Tyres / WSCC Speed Series awards evening

The points system is easy

Marshal at any MSA event – 1 point per event (2 point max per weekend where ran over such)

Marshal at a WSCC Track day – 1 point per event

Marshal at any WSCC Speed Series round – 2 points per event

Marshal at a WSCC organised Speed Series round (e.g. Curborough) – 3 points

The points can be collected throughout the year, but to keep things simple and allow for administration only events occurring between the start and finish of the speed series will be accepted. So that's March 2008 until October 2008.

Proof of attendance of marshaling will be either a copy of your marshal attendance card which you receive with a MSA marshals licence (*how posh*) and must be signed by an official at every event or a copy of the form below, for each event you have undertaken

Furthermore, for those that really get the bug and want to be fully involved in marshals duties, we will be looking to sponsor and reduce the cost of various marshaling equipment. This usually consists of items such as, Orange Proban overalls, stout footwear, plenty of thermals, waterproofs and a big flask and lunch-box !

However, as a beginner don't worry about equipment, we are looking to sort out discounts as the initiative develops and you won't be turned away if you haven't got overalls at your first events. Being a marshal is cheap and great fun, you won't get any closer to the action.

So if you fancy giving it a go at getting closer to motor-sport without the financial outlay required for competing send me your name, address age and experience (*marshaling of course !*)

Your details will be added to the register. Offer further advice, point you in the direction of a local MSA training course and forward details to sprint event organisers.
